DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: This trial is open to NSDTRs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club have obtained an AKC or PAL/ILP number, except bitches in heat, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. NSDTRs with accepted foreign registration numbers are eligible to participate.

OBSTACLES: Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the regulations for Agility Trials.

CRATING SPACE: Limited crating indoors. Ex-pens and tents can be set up outside.

WARM-UPS: A warm-up area consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for all exhibitors.

FOOD: Food is not available on the show site for exhibitors at this trial. There are restaurants nearby.

REFUNDS: Entry fees for bitches that come into season and injured dogs after the closing date will be refunded (minus a \$15.00 administrative fee per day) if a veterinarian certificate is presented to the trial secretary prior to the start of judging. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by vet or judge, or barred from competition by action of the trial committee.

RINGSIDE: Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner/handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Please help your fellow competitors, the trial workers, and the judge by checking in with the gate steward well ahead of your run, and being prompt at the line when your turn comes to run.

SAFETY/BEHAVIOR: The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. **All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated warm-up area.**

LIABILITY: It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever Club (USA) and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. All measurements are at the dog's withers.

Regular classes

Dogs MAY enter a higher jump height.

8 inches - 11" & under at the withers
12 inches - 14" & under at the withers
16 inches - 18" & under at the withers
20 inches - 22" & under at the withers
24 inches - Over 22" at the withers
26 inches - May be entered at owner's discretion

Preferred Classes

Dogs MAY NOT enter a higher jump height
4 inches - 11" & under at the withers
8 inches - 14" & under at the withers
12 inches - 18" & under at the withers
16 inches - 22" & under at the withers
20 inches - Over 22" at the withers

CATALOGS: Dogs entered in the agility trial will be included in the national catalog.

PRIZE AND AWARDS: Rosettes will be awarded for the 1st through 4th place dogs in each STD

and JWW class. A green qualifying ribbon will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score. "New Title" ribbons will be available for qualifying teams. A MACH/PAX bar and Rosette will be awarded to each team earning a MACH/PAX. The club reserves the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value. All awards and prizes must be claimed at the show as none will be mailed.

1st Prize: Blue, 2nd Place: Red, 3rd Place: Yellow, 4th Place: White
Qualifying Ribbon: Dark Green



Etched 6" x 6" tile High in Trial Awards for Novice (Donated by: Kitty Warner), Open (Donated by: Kathy Guerra) and Excellent (Donated by Jim & Lisa Leatherby) levels will be given for the highest combined scores in the STD and JWW classes.

Explanation of HIT: High In Trial prizes awarded for the highest combined (Regular & Preferred Standard and Jumpers with Weaves) qualifying score in Excellent, Open, and Novice regardless of A, B, or Preferred divisions. In the event of tie scores, the fastest JWW time wins.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option effective April 1, 2010. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and by any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list for this event, and further agree to be bound by the "Agreement" printed above on this entry form. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. This entry is submitted for acceptance on the foregoing representation and Agreement.
