Included in the entry fee:

An Event Recording fee of \$3.50 for the first entry of each dog and an Event Recording fee of \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog. These fees are collected by the show giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club.

Move-ups will be allowed until October 14th, 2017. Move-ups submitted before September 10th will be included in the Catalog. Move ups after September 10th will appear in the marked results catalog sent to the AKC.

- From the north or south: Take I-4 West to exit 64 (a west exit). Go west on US Highway 192, and after two miles, make a right onto Maingate Lane. The hotel is one quarter of a mile down on your right.

Entries not on an Official AKC Entry Form or photocopy of an entry form without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not valid. Express Mail entries must be clearly marked. **NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED.** Entries will be returned to sender if no one is present to sign for receipt of the express mail.

**ALL ENTRIES MUST BE LEGIBLE AND FILLED OUT COMPLETELY, MUST INCLUDE AKC AGREEMENT PAGE AND JUMP HEIGHT OR THEY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

This club does not agree to arbitrate as set forth on the official AKC entry form for this event.

ENTRIES ARE LIMITED and will be taken on first come first received basis, (so get your entries in early).

Entry Fees: Includes \$3.50 for AKC event recording fee and a \$3.00 event service fee for the first entry and a \$3.00 event service fee for each additional entry of the same dog each day. Entry fees are \$25.00 for the first entry each day regular class and \$15.00 for each additional entry of the same dog,/same trial (AKC Dog Show Rules Chapter 11, Section 2).

ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED IN THE EVENT A DOG IS ABSENT, DISQUALIFIED, OR EXCUSED BY THE JUDGE OR VETERINARIAN, OR BARRED FROM COMPETITION BY THE TRIAL COMMITTEE. IF RIOTS, CIVIL DISTURBANCES, OR OTHER ACTS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THE CLUB MAKES IT IMPOSSIBLE TO OPEN OR COMPLETE THE TRIAL, NO REFUND OF ENTRY FEES WILL BE GRANTED.

Bitches that come into season, after the closing date of the entries, may have the entry fee returned less \$5.00 – upon written request from the owner or handler on or before date of trial. A Veterinarians certification will be required in order to receive a refund.

Dogs should be present at least one half hour before they are to be judged. The owner or handler is solely responsible for having their dog at ringside when it is due in the ring. Dog not required for further judging may be excused.

Crating Area is limited, X-pens are not allowed. Please be respectful of each other's area. Do not leave dogs unattended for extended amounts of time.

**Crate setup can begin one hour before the start of the trial in the Oleander Ball Room.**

Dogs not entered in the trial are NOT permitted on the grounds.

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.
