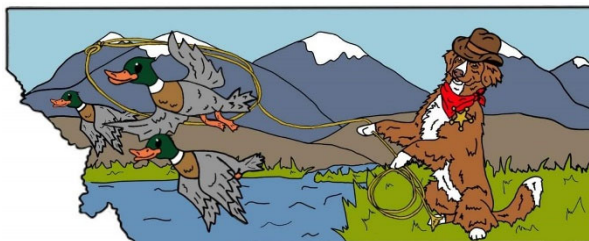

COVID protocols in place for this event will be determined by guidelines and recommendations that are in place at the time of the event. CDC, State of Montana, Carbon County, AKC, NSDTRC (USA) and Yellowstone Dog Sports resources will be used to develop final protocols and they will be detailed in the exhibitor's confirmation letter. *By entering these trials, you agree to accept and abide by any requirements in place during the trials.*

POTENTIAL requirements *may* include:

- Completed and signed facility and/or club waiver of liability.
- Wearing an acceptable face covering or mask that covers both nose and mouth indoors or during certain activities (judges briefing, walking courses or others).
- Social distancing and masks required indoors when distance cannot be maintained.
- Limited crating indoors.
- Limited persons in building (judge, ring crew, competitors, observers) at any one time.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

Wherever the word "dog" is used in this premium, it includes both sexes. This trial is open to NSDTR dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration or Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) as NSDTR. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) as NSDTR must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Dogs entered should be physically sound. Not eligible are dogs that are blind, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

**An entry is defined as a single run by a single dog, in a single class.*

Entry fees include a \$3.50 per run AKC recording fee.

Online Entries may be made via the AKC online entry system. Online entries are encouraged as USPS mail delivery is inconsistent and timing unreliable.

During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries will be designated as follows: Online entries 100; Paper entries 150. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hr period, the club and secretary reserve the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly.

No entries will be accepted by phone, email, fax, or hand delivery. If you are sending entries by "express" or "overnight" mail, you **MUST** use USPS Priority or Priority Express to the Trial Secretary's PO Box and must include the signature waiver. No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. Entries that do not include the correct amount of entry fees will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor.

WAIT LIST INFORMATION

The club is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 25 runs will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait-listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the closing date and time. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund.

Jump Height Divisions

Please check the box on the entry form so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs to Be Measured List.

All dogs competing must have a valid AKC Jump Height Card OR be reasonably entered at an appropriate height. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter the dog at an appropriate height. Failure to do so may result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" jump height division. If a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Representative is present and wishes to provide measurements; dogs without a valid Jump Height Card (including those entered in the 24" jump height division) may be measured during the trial.

If you are entering your dog in both Regular and Preferred classes, **a separate entry form is required for each.**

Exhibitors should consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description of, and eligibility for entry into, classes, and for complete information about jump heights. It is the exhibitor's express responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class and jump height. After the closing date/time, the Trial Secretary cannot make corrections to entries if the error is a mistake on the entry as received. HINT: Carefully review your preliminary confirmation!

MOVEUPS BEFORE THE TRIAL

Move-ups as a result of titles earned after entries close must be submitted in writing or email so that the Trial Secretary receives them by **6:00 PM MDT on Friday, September 3**. Include the dog's call name, owner's name, class dog is moving from, and class dog is moving to (HINT: replying to your final CONFIRMATION EMAIL is an ideal way to complete a move-up). If you do not receive acknowledgement of your move-up request within 24 hours of sending, please contact the TRIAL SECRETARY (via text or email) to make sure that it was received. No phone move ups accepted.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

A qualifying score is required for the awarding of ribbons and prizes in all agility classes. All trophy donors will be listed in the catalog. Custom wood trophies are crafted by Alexander Westerso, Laz3D Designs.

Placement rosettes will be awarded in each class as follows:

<i>First Place</i>	<i>Blue</i>
<i>Second Place</i>	<i>Red</i>
<i>Third Place</i>	<i>Yellow</i>
<i>Fourth Place</i>	<i>White</i>
<i>Qualifying Score</i>	<i>Dark Green</i>

First Place in Each Class will be awarded an Engraved Cutting Board.

Each High in Trial winner (Regular, Preferred, Premier and Preferred Premier) will be awarded an Engraved Cutting Board.

HIGH IN TRIAL CALCULATIONS

The method for determining the High in Trial awards will be detailed in the trial information sent after closing.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility by downloading them at www.akc.org.

Safety, Behavior and Liability: The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever Club (USA) (NSDTRC) and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The NSDTRC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the NSDTRC or any official thereof.

During trial hours, all dogs must be on leash at all times when on site at YDS except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course. The indoor arena TURF is NOT a designated exercise or play area for dogs. There are inherent risks for dogs who are off leash at Yellowstone Dog Sports which include but are not limited to: highway and other vehicle traffic, operating tractors, coyotes and other wildlife including bears and moose, stray dogs, open ponds, irrigation

ditches, holes, barbed wire and other agricultural or construction debris. Dog owners accept full responsibility for injuries sustained by the handler, their dog or any guests attending the event with an exhibitor.

Crating space inside the arena may not be available for all entered exhibitors. Crating spots may be assigned by the trial committee.

Food at the Trial

Light breakfast and lunch items will be made available for purchase. Exhibitors should plan dinner on their own. More information will be included in the Trial Information sent after closing.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund except as described in the Wait List section above.

Bitches in season will be refunded the full entry fee. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the trial.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the entrance gate when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

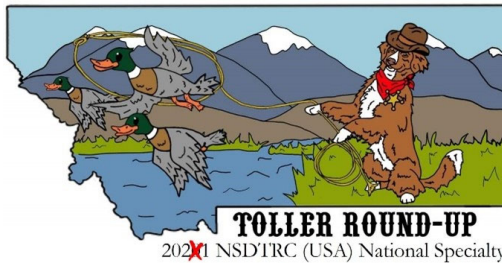
Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

When submitted, entry forms must be legible, and include correct fees, the agreement (next/back page), and the owner/agent's signature. Incomplete and/or illegible entry forms will not be processed. **Please provide a legible email address**, as all trial information after closing will be provided via email.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division. All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. I (we) agree that the determination of whether the injury is serious shall be made by the event veterinarian and is binding on me (us).
